10 books = 1 pupil, 250 = a classroom, 2000 = a school

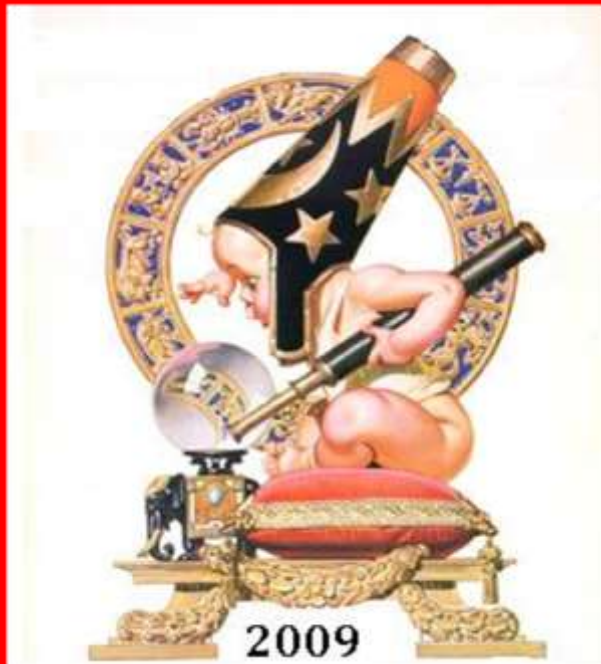
