By 6 PM we had worked nearly 200 paintings into the system ready to be judged tomorrow . What a team!

Let's keep up the momentum by a concerted effort over the weekend receiving the balance of the works from the artists and showing COURTESY and PATIENCE .

## From The Board

The Board has endorsed the Art Show Committee's recommendation that we hold next year's Art Show at Caulfield Racecourse at the end of May.

Boroondara Council has not replied to a request for a situation report on the predicted state of the Civic Centre's alterations as at April 2010, forcing our hand due to an imminent deadline on forward bookings for Caulfield .

Funding for 4 Shelterboxes was approved to replace 2 used in the Victorian Bushfires and 2 for international emergencies .
